FLAP TORQUE SHAFT ASSEMBLY INSPECTION

MODELS AFFECTED: Thrush Models S2R-T660 S/N T660-101 and S/N T660-103 through 112.

REASON FOR PUBLICATION: A report from the field indicated cracks were found on the torque shaft assembly

P/N 95661T001. These cracks were located around the weld attaching flap linkage arm P/N 95678-1 to the torque shaft. The purpose of this letter is to have

the affected assembles inspected and repaired as required.

COMPLIANCE: As soon as possible.

BY WHOM THE WORK

MAY BE ACCOMPLISHED: A&P Mechanic or equivalent.

APPROVAL: Thrush Aircraft, Inc. Engineering.

MAN HOURS: Approximately 1.0 hour for inspection.

INSPECTION: Remove wing fuselage fairing / skins as required to gain access to flap torque

shaft on both sides of airplane. Visually inspect torque shaft in the immediate area of the flap linkage arm P/N 95678-1 for indications of cracking. Suspected

cracks should be inspected using dye penetrant.

REPAIR: Remove and replace with new torque shaft assembly or repair defective torque

shaft assemblies per AC 43.13-1B Section 5.
