ELEVATOR TRIM TAB MECHANISM

EFFECTIVITY: Aero Commander Model S-2R Thrush, Serial No. 1416R

thru 1580R

REASON FOR PUBLICATION: Service investigation has revealed that linkage wear may

exist in the elevator trim tab bellcrank assembly in the Model S-2R, which could result in unacceptable trim conditions.

As a solution, the following instructions are recommended.

COMPLIANCE: At owner's discretion.

APPROVAL: FAA DER Approved

INSTRUCTION:

1. Set elevator trim in neutral position and remove bellcrank assemblies shown on Sheet 2. Do not change push rod lengths in any manner.

- 2. Replace with (improved) 70270 bellcrank assemblies, using original hardware.
- Check for proper rigging.


