## SPRAY PRESSURE LINE FLEX HOSE

**EFFECTIVITY:** MODEL S-2R, SERIAL NO'S 1831R THRU 2071R

REASON FOR PUBLICATION: In some instances, certain chemicals have affected the flex

hose between the line strainer and the spray pressure gage line. This Service Letter is being issued to provide a better

flex hose to alleviate this situation.

## INSTRUCTION:

- a. Assure that valve assembly, forward of line strainer, is empty of chemicals.
- b. Remove and discard existing flex hose from line strainer assembly (see Figure 1.).
- c. Install 80809-5 hose using existing clamps (see Figure 1.).
- d. Fill out and mail compliance card.


